



East Brimfield...the Lost Village

A short distance south of Rt. 20 on the road from Holland to East Brimfield stands a small, isolated wooden church. It seems odd in New England to find a lonely church without a community around it, and, indeed, it was not always so.

Once this church was the centerpiece of a thriving village, and the Holland-East Brimfield Road led to more than an empty highway intersection.

East Brimfield is a "lost village" in the town of Brimfield, a smaller-scale version of the lost towns of the Quabbin and sacrificed for similar reasons. Whereas the four

Quabbin towns were removed to create a huge reservoir that supplies water to the Boston metropolitan area, East Brimfield was abandoned as part of a flood control project.

After floods resulting from the hurricanes of 1955 devastated towns down the Quinebaug River Valley, the US Army Corps of Engineers launched a massive flood control project to prevent that kind of disaster from repeating. By the early 1960s the Corps had completed dams at East Brimfield, Westville (in Sturbridge and Southbridge), and West Thompson, CT. In each case a community was sacrificed. Villages like East Brimfield do not lie directly beneath the dam and are usually not underwater, but they were within the potential high-water line of the reservoir and had to be removed.

East Brimfield was one of hundreds of textile mill villages that sprang up in southern New England in the early 1800s, when the disruptions of the Napoleonic wars opened a window of opportunity for American manufacturing. The East Brimfield mill, built around 1815 or 1816, faced stiff competition from domestic rivals and British goods, which flowed back into America

after the War of 1812. Never outstandingly successful, the East Brimfield mill changed hands several times. In 1854 the original factory burned and was rebuilt, probably on the same foundation, as a sprawling three-story wooden structure.

East Brimfield's heyday began in 1883 when the Snell Manufacturing Co., centered in Fiskdale (Sturbridge), acquired the plant to expand its production of bits and augers. Today Snell tools and catalogs sometimes show up at local flea markets or on the Internet.

From the Brimfield-Sturbridge Road (present Rt. 20) to beyond the Quinebaug River, the Holland-East Brimfield Road was lined with houses, some of them multi-family tenements. Many were large, solid structures, built at various times in the 19th Century, some probably as company housing. The church was erected in 1872 so that local people wouldn't have to travel to Brimfield center or Fiskdale. East Brimfield also had an elementary school, located on present Rt. 20, and a country store/post office. The village even had streetlights and a concrete sidewalk, built as a 1930s work project.

An electric railway (trolley) line was completed in 1907 and provided hourly service between Worcester and Springfield. In 1912

work began on the Southern New England (Grand Trunk) Railroad between Palmer and Providence, part of a vast transcontinental railroad scheme that was never completed. Abutments for the electric railway and the Grand Trunk can still be seen in the East Brimfield Reservoir.

The full account of East Brimfield's rise and fall will be told in a special program at Old Sturbridge Village on Wednesday, July 30. Corps of Engineers Ranger Merl Bassett and historian Larry Lowenthal of Brimfield will describe their efforts to make sure that East

Brimfield is no longer a forgotten village. This program, part of the OSV Community History Series, starts at 8 PM in the Fuller Conference Center, located just beyond the tavern and gift shop.

Much of the program is based on interviews of former East Brimfield residents, and numerous old photos will bring the lost village to life. Most of these photos come from original glass negatives taken by well-known Brimfield photographer F. Edgar Brown between about 1905 and 1912. Messrs. Bassett and Lowenthal also explain changes in the road layout during the last 150 years and compare old maps with the present course of Rt. 20, which is the third version of the highway thru the area.

In an earlier program on the same evening, beginning at 7 PM, Rick Magee of the Corps of Engineers will present "Lewis & Clark and New England: What is the Connection?" Dressed in period costume (US Army Infantry 1802 regulation), Magee will portray and interpret Thomas Proctor Howard, a soldier from Brimfield who enlisted in Lewis and Clark's Corps of Discovery. The presentation includes a recreated "box of artifacts" related to the historic expedition. For further information contact Mark Ashton at Old Sturbridge Village (508/347-0217) or Merl Bassett (508/347-3705).

Family Heirlooms

Webster's Dictionary defines an heirloom as "A piece of property that descends to the heir as an inseparable part of an inheritance. Something of special value handed on from one generation to another."

My husband Frank celebrated a very proud occasion this past Memorial Day when his father gifted him a gun that had descended through his family since before the Revolutionary War in 1771. It came with a "call to arms" directed to his great, great, great, great, great, grandfather, John Gould. It was the one of the most special objects Frank has ever wanted to own and now he does. With that ownership comes those same questions which arise at the important times in your life. The day you're married or your first child is born. The days when you realize you're part of a much larger plan, perhaps you can share in this experience.

Once we got over the warm and fuzzy feeling, our next thoughts were "What's it worth?" and "Do we need special insurance?" Both of these questions lead me on a discovery mission. After days of internet research I decided it was worth enough to warrant special insurance, but didn't really matter exactly how much because it was irreplaceable and because we would never sell it. It's not ours to sell, it's ours to enjoy until we pass it to our boys. Since both Frank and I are from old New England families, we both have the pleasure and honor of owning many family heir-looms, but during this recent passing of the goods, several things were said which made us stop and wonder.

During our discussion with Frank's father he discounted certain things in the house as potential heirlooms saying things like "Well your grandfather

just bought that." Frank and I looked at each other as if to say "So, that doesn't count?" Our conversation over the past few days keeps coming around to this same topic. We keep asking ourselves, and each other, a litany of questions such as...When does something become an heirloom? Are we snowballs, rolling through time, accumulating objects that will remain after our lives or will the kids hawk it the first moment they can? Which objects are worthy of keeping and making into family heirlooms? Which is one step above the trash pile? Why does one person covet an object and another could just as well throw it in the landfill?

Later in this same week, we were asked into a Lake Wentworth home of a woman whose father had been a Doctor and book collector. At the end of



the Doctors life, the obvious thing happened...the Dr. couldn't take the books, leaving his daughter over-

whelmed with the prospect of what to do with all these books, pamphlets, maps, town histories and general ephemera. The timing was perfect because it was just before we were to exhibit at the New England Antiquarian Book Fair in Concord, NH and so we were able to help her by taking some of this material on consignment to the upcoming book fair.

This women's situation brought our discussion around once again to family heirlooms. How many objects and of what value do we need to remember any one person in our lives. Or is it our lot, our sole purpose in life to sustain the family heritage? Are we the keepers of the past?

When I was first starting in business, I asked my

Dad for an old cast iron kettle in his basement to use on my wood stove. He allowed I could use saying "It came from the farm in Maine - promise you'll never get rid of it". Well, I kept my promise and now my father's long gone, I've been in business over 15 years, and I still carry this 20 pound cast iron kettle of little value with me through life, just because my father told me "never to get rid of it". So the lesson Dad taught me was - be careful what you tell your children. They do listen.



I love going to museums where they have objects from ancient civilizations. I recently visited the Naval Yard in Bermuda and was so amazed some of the most special treasures from the past were just a simple coin or button. Our connection is with the object, but it's the shadow of the soul we can see reflected in the object, which connects us to the past.

Our affluent society is drowning in a sea of objects. It intrigues me to stop and think about what one object will survive as representative of my life and who will be the keeper. What will survive 1,000 years from now to say the Baby Boomers were here? Whatever it is, it'll have to be something grand.







DIRECTIONS TO BRIMFIELD

From the East: Boston, Providence and Worcester From Boston and points east take the Mass Turnpike (Rt. 90) west to Exit 9 (Sturbridge). Follow Route 20 west to Brimfield, about 7 miles to the only set of traffic lights. From the lights in Brimfield center, continue west. The markets begin just after the big white church on the right. BrimfieldExchange is located in our show booth, about 0.4 miles on the left (South) side of Route 20, opposite May's Antique Market, and between J & J and Hertan's. Paid parking is available along route 20 on both sides of the road. The Brimfield antique shows (markets) extend about 1 mile west of the church along route 20.

From the West: Albany and Springfield From Springfield and points west take the Mass Turnpike (Rt. 90) east to exit 8 (Palmer). After exiting the toll, turn right on route 32 south. Proceed 0.6 miles to next set of lights in Palmer. From the lights turn left on route 20 east toward Brimfield, and proceed about 6.8 miles to the end of the divided highway. The markets(shows) begin at a little over 7.0 miles and extend east for about a mile. BrimfieldExchange is located in our show booth, about 7.8 miles on the right (South) side of Route 20, opposite May's Antique Market, and between J & J and Hertan's. Paid parking is available along route 20 on both sides of the road.

From the South: NYC and Hartford Take route I-95 north to New Haven, then 91 north to Hartford. Pick up I-84 east in Hartford. Follow I-84 east to the Sturbridge exit for route 20 west, or from I-84 follow route 32 north to route 19 north to Brimfield light and turn left (west). From here follow east directions above.




